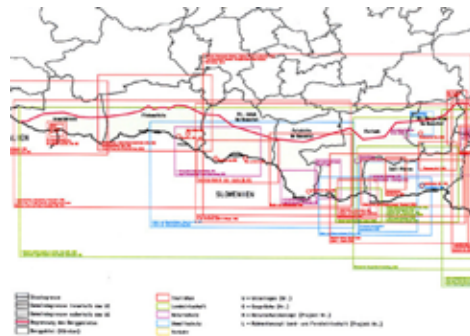

ALPINE CONCEPT CARINTHIA – SLOVENIA INTERREG II

Project description

The Alpine Concept Carinthia – Slovenia (Southern Limestone Alps, resp.) covers the fields of tourism, agriculture and forestry as well as the protection of natural resources. It is considering the results of the scientific research on alpine space and the thereof derived political definitions of the Alpine Convention. The concept is to initiate a coordinated cross-border implementation of projects for the public benefit of the local population meeting all subject-specific requirements of nature conservation and environmental protection.

The project area includes alpine regions, situated on carinthian territory along the 170 kilometers long border with Slovenia.
