PROTECTED AREA DEVELOPMENT NATURA 2000 SITE "ELSGRABEN-MANNSBERG" CARINTHIA / AUSTRIA

Project description

The area around the Elsgraben- Mannsberg is to become the largest Natura 2000 Site of the carinthian lowlands. The diversity of different beech forest types in a confined area, the large number of protected orchids like the Ladies Slipper and the occurrence of species of outstanding european importance (the Jersey Tiger and the Rosalia longicorn beetle as so-called "priority species") enhance this area into a site of ecological uniqueness.
