SKI RESORT AULI –UTTARAKHAND (INDIA)

The Governmental Tourism Organisation of Uttarakhand intends to hold the Alpine and Nordic Skiing competitions of the First South Asian Federation Winter Games 2008/09 at Auli, a ski resort on the southern slope of Himalaya mountains. Furthermore in the next few years the ski resort Auli should be developed to a ski resort of world class standard with increasing capacity for accommodation and vertical transport.

project information

The proposed development of the ski resort should be carried out in two phases:

- A) Enlargement 1: Facilities for alpine competitions of the winter games
- * construction of new ski slope for FIS-homologation
 - * installation of new »FIS-lift« to reach the starting point of the FIS-slope
 - * construction of snow making system
- B) Enlargement 2: continuous further development of the skiing capacity
- * construction of new gondola-ropeway in two sections
 - * construction of about 10 hectares of new ski slopes
 - * extension of artificial snow making system

Hand in hand with the expansion of skiing facilities, the development of accommodation and traffic infrastructure is to be advanced.
